


Notes from Your Senior Warden

St. Catherine of Alexandria Mission Statement: "To nurture each other in the knowledge and love of God – Father, Son and Holy Spirit – and to share the Good News with all.

Mother Susan has asked that the Senior Warden make some comments moving forward as part of the Wheel in her absence. I will try to share with you in the coming weeks and months some of my thoughts. I will also include any activities or events that may significant to all.

This month I want to briefly describe some of our ministries and how we are organized to function in order to fulfill our Mission Statement and service to our Lord. I want to begin with a brief description of our six Commission/Ministries and the vision for the functions they serve in our parish.

<u>SERVICE COMMISSION</u> – "Ministers to those who are in need who are **not** members of St. Catherine's." This Commission generally serves as our voice in outreach to our community both locally and universally. This Commission typically meets the first Wednesday Evening of each month.



<u>EDUCATION COMMISSION</u> – "Plans, Implements and evaluates all Christian Education programs". This Commission typically meets once per month after a 10am service. This Commission works with the Education Director on curriculum, special events and other education activities. This commission typically meets after a 10am service on Sunday.

<u>EVANGELISM COMMISSION</u> – "Ministry intended to bring new members to St. Catherine's". This commission will meet after a 10am service on Sunday. This ministry directs activities to attract new members including the website, printed material and events and activities to attract newcomers to our parish. They also minister to those parishioners who were one time members of our parish but have since left St. Catherine's for any number of reasons.

<u>PARISH LIFE COMMISSION</u> – "Plans and executes fellowship for the members of St. Catherine's". This commission typically meets first Wednesday evening of each month. This commission plans activities and events to help celebrate our life here at St. Catherine's.

<u>PASTORAL CARE MINISTRY</u> – "Provide support and care for those current parishioners of St. Catherine's in need". This ministry provides support, hospital visits, home visits, meals, cards, phone calls and communion to those members of St. Catherine's who are in need and unable to attend church.

We are in need of volunteers for each of these commissions and ministries. If you would like to volunteer your talents to one of these ministries, please let me or the office or the Priest or any member of the Vestry know. Our parish is only as strong as the people in it and the work we all do to serve our Lord. I would ask that you prayerfully consider where you can best utilize your skills and talents in the service of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

Next month I will talk about some of the other committees and groups that are a part of our daily lives at St. Catherine of Alexandria Episcopal Church.

In these times of divisiveness and discontent with our world and in particular the political situation in this country, we might pray and think about Paul's letter to the Ephesians in Chapter 4:2 "... be completely humble and gentle, be patient, bearing with one another in love."

THE PASTORAL CARE MINISTRY

The Pastoral Care Ministry will be overseeing a website for people to sign up, on specific dates, to prepare meals for Mother Susan and her family.

We have selected Sunday and Wednesday as days for meals to be delivered to the church. These are the days with the greatest traffic in the church. Meals brought to either service on Sunday will be placed in the refrigerator in the kitchen, and delivered to her home by a care team member. Wednesday meals can be brought on Committee, Commission and Vestry night and also placed in refrigerator. They will be delivered on Wednesday night or Thursday. Please include heating instructions. Disposable containers are best. Other dishes should be marked with names and will be returned to the church.

One may select an open date by clicking on available date and then signing in with name, email address and pass code. Then you may click on an open date and enter meal you are bringing. On note line indicate that you will bring to church on that day. You may return to the site again once you have registered, and check your information or select another date. You will be reminded by email the day prior.






