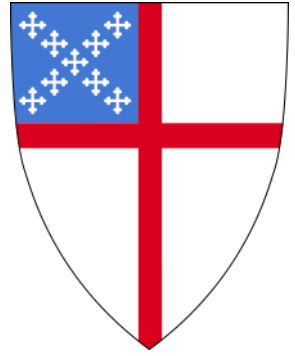

Dear people of St. Catherine's,

I am delighted to tell you that I have hired Cloud Ssu-Yun Wang as our interim organist/choir director! Cloud is a wonderful musician who lives out her faith by sharing music with the people of God. We are blessed to have her with us, at least through February of 2019. We are continuing to take applications for the permanent position through January of 2019, and Cloud will be eligible to apply for this position. Cloud brings incredible musical skills and energy, as well as a wonderful spirit, to her work. Her first Sunday will be November 4th. Cloud had a few previous commitments but she will be with us most Sundays from now through the end of February!



This Sunday, November 4th, we celebrate The Feast of All Saints'. This is one of the major feasts of our Christian calendar. At St. Catherine's we continue our tradition of hanging beautiful banners with the names of those who have died in the past year. Sunday November 11th is our Ingathering Sunday. We are invited to bring our pledge cards, symbolizing our gifts of material support for God's work in this parish, to be blessed on this day. We also will celebrate our patron saint, St. Catherine of Alexandria. This is a good day to wear red, or your St. Catherine's T-shirt, if you have one, as the liturgical color is Red.

This month also brings our national celebration of Thanksgiving. Prayers for all who travel in this season, and for all who are grieving the loss of a family member.

The season of Advent begins the first Sunday of December. Advent invites us into a time of waiting, of listening for God's voice in our lives. Advent is a time of preparation of our hearts for the celebration of the mystery of the Incarnation.

On Saturday December 1 I will lead an Advent Wisdom retreat day. There will be times of meditation, silence, scripture, sacred chants and material from the Christian Wisdom tradition. St. Catherine of Alexandria Stewardship Update November 2018:

At the risk of downplaying the call to return ten percent of the annual treasure we receive from God each year through our financial pledge, I would like to say a few words about time and talent, the other two components of our Stewardship campaign. Each component is critical and one does not diminish the need for the other two. We hear much about our call to tithing and proportional giving but not as much about time and talent.

Have you ever wondered what purpose or action God had in mind for you during your time on earth? I used to think that it had to be something spectacular that I was definitely not worthy of until Fr. Ed Henley explained the difference between “Kairos” God’s time measurement and “Kronos” man’s time measurement. It was only then that I could think of actions in terms of minutes, hours days, etc. as being a measurable time frame of the action that God has called us to. I could also then accept the idea that God would know but I might never know what positive actions I had carried out in His plan. What seemed to be most important was being available.

We have all been given many gifts and talents that Christ can use in furthering His work at St. Catherine’s. So when you’re filling out your pledge card this month, think of some of the time and talents you can pledge to His work.

In the words of Khalil Gibran, a Lebanese Maronite Catholic poet and author of the best selling book, “The Prophet”, “You give but little when you give of your possessions. It is when you give of yourself that you truly give.”

Cloud Ssu-yun Wang's Bio

Extraordinary Artist Cloud Ssu-Yun Wang is originally from Taiwan. She began playing the piano when she was just 6 years old. Her musical journey includes playing the recorder, pianica and accordion in the elementary school band; serving as the accompanist for the middle school men's choir; singing in the choir, and playing percussion in the symphonic band in both high school and college. She received her Bachelor's degree in classical music from National Sun Yat-Sen University in Taiwan. Influenced by jazz vibraphone virtuoso Gary Burton, she decided to come to the United States. She was awarded a scholarship to Berklee College of Music in Boston, MA where she learned the jazz vibraphone, percussion, all diversity of the music, and jazz composition. In 2010, she received the second prize for vibraphone in Italy at the Percussion Competition in Fermo, Italy. In 2013, she was awarded the jazz performance diploma from Berklee.



Cloud got involved with the pipe organ and handbells in 2014. Cloud is active in both AGO (American Guild of Organist) and the Handbell Musicians of America: including receiving the scholarship in 2016 from Pittsburgh Organ Academy; the guest organist and performed in many concerts and churches, include her solo concerts in West Virginia, Pennsylvania, and Florida. Being part of Big Ring (host by The Army Salvation and The Handbell Musician of America, 664 ringers to break the Guinness World Record to become the largest handbell ensemble in the world, Bloomington, MN (2016); attending Handbell festivals and workshops in OH, PA, and NJ. She was awarded the scholarship to the National Handbell Seminar in Rochester, NY. She was also a member of Ring Pittsburgh Handbell Ensemble in Pittsburgh from 2016 to 2017. She is currently a member of the AGO Central Florida Chapter and studies organ with Dr. Neal Campbell, the music director at Trinity Episcopal Church in Vero Beach. She also studies the carillon with Dr. Ellis Laura at University of Florida in Gainesville.

Being a church musician is a calling for Cloud. She has numerous experiences serving in Presbyterian, United Methodist, Anglican, Catholic, and non-denominational churches. Cloud is grateful that God gave her the music talent to serve God's people.

Now Cloud lives in Tampa, FL. She teaches piano and percussion. She is also the guest accompanist and handbell ringer in the Tampa area.

Cloud is funny, creative, sweet and unique. Besides music, she enjoys cooking, traveling and building LEGOs in her free time. She is looking forward to spending time with you at St. Catherine of Alexandria Episcopal Church.

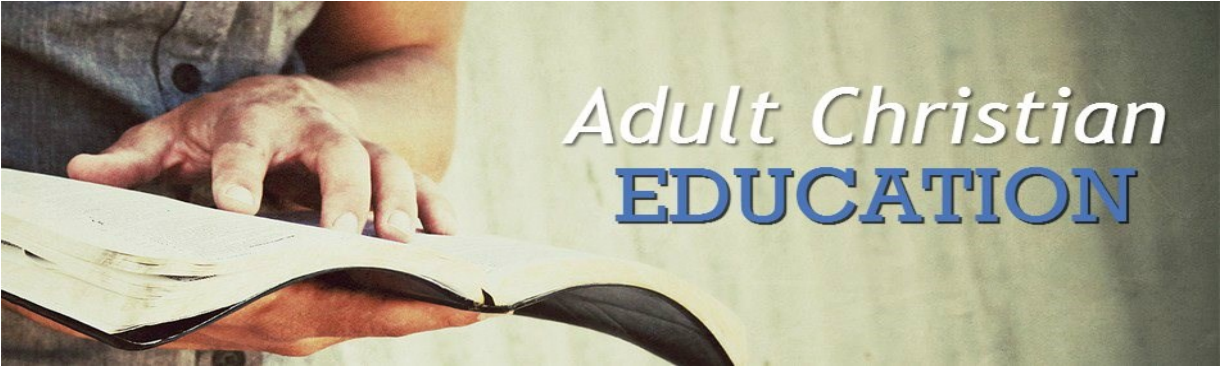

The Brotherhood/Sisterhood of Loaves and Fish

I am very sorry to report that the participation in the Brotherhood/Sisterhood breakfast program has declined dramatically over the last few years. I am sure that is directly related to the reduction in attendance at the 10 o'clock Mass. There was a time when we served an AVERAGE of 85 individuals on any given Sunday. Over the last year we have averaged 40.2 servings each Sunday. (Not including the Parish Meeting and Easter). Due to the overall reduction in attendance, along with the decline in the number of cooking teams, (from 10 to 5 teams) that does put a strain on the remaining 5 teams. Three of those teams are led by Frank Sr., my wife, Joan Kaywell, and Frank Jr. It takes as many prep hours weekly to serve 110 as it does to serve 25 (Sept. 9th of this year).

As of this past June the Brotherhood has functioned and served our parish for 30 years, I have been leading this group for 22 of those years. We have served breakfast almost every Sunday and other events as needed. It is a tradition that is not matched by any other church that I know of in the diocese. The question I have to ask is, has the Brotherhood outlasted its usefulness to St. Catherine's Church family?

I am prayerfully asking for your input and any suggestions you might have regarding ways in which the Brotherhood can improve our service to our church family. Please respond to the following questions. Your thoughtful input will direct us into the best way to serve our Parish and our church family. 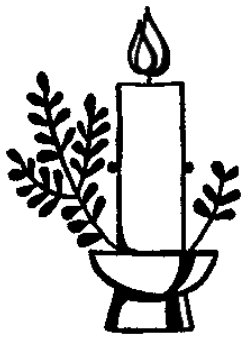

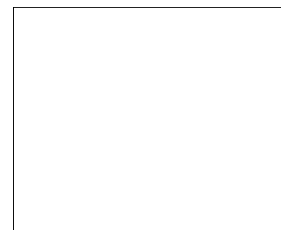
