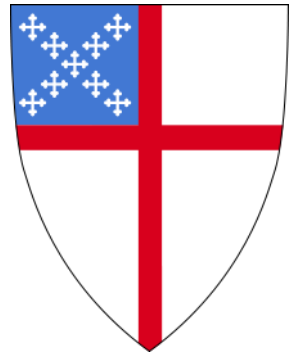




News from St. Catherine's Episcopal Church

Dear people of St. Catherine's,

Advent is here – that great liturgical season when we pray and sing out of our longing for God and the fulfillment of God's plans, for a world where, as Isaiah prophesied, swords will be beat into plowshares, and spears into pruning hooks, and we will not learn war anymore....

Advent is a wonderful season to focus on our spiritual lives. As the writer John Shea has suggested, if our bodies or our finances are in trouble, we put our focus and energy there to help. But we often treat our spirit as a luxury, not a necessity. Too often we put our spiritual life on hold, or even let it languish. The message in Advent is "Keep Awake"! We are invited to pay attention to our spiritual lives, especially in Advent. Here are some practical suggestions:

I invite you all to join me in a daily prayer practice this Advent. Some of you already use the Forward Day by Day, and some do the Daily Office. Perhaps you will choose to pray Evening Prayer this Advent – in our chapel Monday through Thursday evenings at 6 p.m. or at your home. Weekly Eucharist and Daily prayer are both important parts of the spiritual practices of our Episcopal/Anglican tradition.

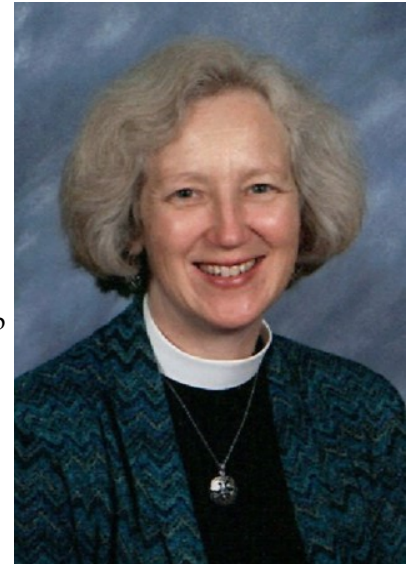
Another way to keep awake is to be more intentional about our actions. Most of us are twice as busy this season. Don't let your busyness get frantic. Take a deep breath. Say a prayer for every person you send a Christmas Card to, or when you buy a present. Nearly everything you do to prepare for this season can be done as a prayer, if you remember to have that intention. Do something for someone else, particularly remembering those who are living in poverty, or alone, or someone who is grieving a recent loss.

We welcome The Rev. Allen W. Farabee as Assisting Priest on December 3 and 4th. I am delighted to have him as a colleague and fellow priest at St. Catherine's while he and his wife Galen are "snow-birds" each year from December through April. Come and welcome them both at the 10 a.m. service on Sunday.

Another exciting, new addition to our life is our brand new website, which should be live December 1st. It is expanded, beautifully designed, interactive, and will be a great evangelism tool for our parish. Thank you again to the Evangelism Commission, the Website Committee, and particularly Sally McDonald for all the hard work on this project!

Finally, I wish all of you a blessed Christmas. If you are in town, please join us for one of our four services (three Christmas Eve and one Christmas Day). May the longing of Advent and the joy of Christmas deepen your love of God and the world.

FROM THE RECTOR

Dear ones,

I am so excited to be able to announce that The Rev. Allen Farabee will be our new part time assisting priest for 5 months a year while he and his wife Galen are “snowbirds” in Florida. He will begin the weekend of December 3 and 4, preaching and celebrating all three Eucharists. Please plan to attend and welcome them both! Many of you have met him and his wife Galen who worshiped with us all last winter at the 10 a.m. service while they were in town. Here is his introduction to you:

Dear People of St. Catherine’s,

I am delighted that Mother Susan has invited me to assist her in the ministry of St. Catharines and I am writing to tell you a little about me. I was born in Ft. Myers and grew up in south Florida, graduating from high school in St. Petersburg. I went off to Indiana University Music School to become a professional singer. However, along the way God called me to ordained ministry and I attended Yale Divinity School, and received graduate degrees from Nashotah House seminary and the University of Connecticut School of Law. After a brief time in ordained ministry in the United Methodist Church, I was ordained priest in the Diocese of Southeast Florida. My journey then took me to Ft. Lauderdale, northern Wisconsin, central Illinois, Litchfield, Connecticut, and finally to Buffalo, NY, where I served for a decade as Dean of St. Paul’s Cathedral.

I retired as Dean in 2004 and have continued to assist my bishop in interim ministry and for the past 8 years as part time vicar of St. David’s Church in West Seneca, a first ring suburb of Buffalo. When I retired as dean I also began a law practice in immigration law, mostly representing persons in immigration court facing deportation. But over the years, Florida kept calling me back. Our younger son, John, came to the University of South Florida for college and stayed. He married a beautiful young woman from Land o Lakes and they now live in Wesley Chapel with our two wonderful grandchildren, Clair and Liam. My wife Galen and I bought a winter home in Wesley Chapel in 2015 and when we searched for a church in which to worship our search led us to you! You welcomed us warmly and we felt at home, complete with grits at breakfast! We will be in Wesley Chapel from December to May, and I look forward to getting to know you, preach and celebrate for you, visit some of you in the hospital, and enjoy your company in Christ.

NOTES FROM THE SERVICE COMMISSION

The St. Vincent de Paul Society food bank at Corpus Christi Church sends reports of its activities to St. Catherine's Service Commission. The reports for July, August, and September showed that the food bank had distributed a total of 28,901 pounds of food to 901 families with 3,347 members during those months. In the past, the food bank supplies are severely depleted after Thanksgiving. Christmas is also a time of high demand, so please be extra generous with your donations for the grocery cart in the vestibule. We always receive a gracious note of thanks for our donations.

NOTES FROM THE TREASURER

Advent Greetings To All,

The calendar and IRS regulations require specific attention to the dates that pledge payments are made for the end of this year and the beginning of next year.

In order for pledge payments or other contributions to be included in your 2016 contributions, they must be received in the offering plates or in the church office NO LATER than Saturday, December 31, 2016 or postmarked no later than December 31, 2016.

Contributions or pledge payments received in the offering plates or in the office on Sunday, January 1, 2017 or later must be included in 2017 contributions or pledge records regardless of the date written on a check.

These are IRS regulations and not an arbitrary policy set up by your church office. As always, we urge everyone to bring all pledge contributions up to date as we wrap up the current year and begin an exciting new year.

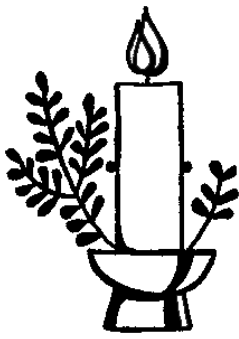

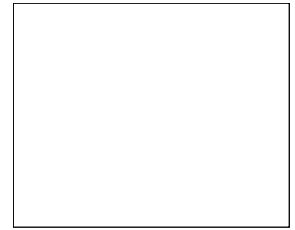
